## Job Summary

The Mid Sussex Supported Housing Service provides Social Care support to 16 adults across our 3 accommodation sites, to individuals who have presented as homeless to Mid Sussex District Council or Crawley Borough Council and have a priority need.

The maximum stay within the service is 6 months and within this time period staff will support clients on their identified needs through support planning with a focus on looking for more permanent accommodation, learning the skills required to maintain a tenancy agreement and ensuring the client is accessing the relevant support with their health and wellbeing.

In addition to the work with clients the role also requires providing an enhanced housing management role focusing on the buildings, rents and reporting of repairs.

## Salary

The salary is paid monthly in arrears and will be £20,191 per annum. An employer's pension contribution of between 3% is also paid. The level of this contribution is reviewed annually.

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## Hours of Work

The hours of work will be 37 hours per week, working Monday – Friday, 9am – 5pm. BHT does not pay overtime but will grant "time off in lieu" if agreed by the Project Manager.

## Annual Holidays

The annual leave entitlement will be 200 hours (27 working days), rising 1 day for each year of service to a maximum of 236 hours (32 days) pro rata. All public bank holidays are granted with two statutory days, to be taken over the Christmas period
