Project/Department Summary

54 Leyland's Road is a 6-bed registered recovery service for clients with mental health issues. Clients reside at 54 Leyland's Road for a medium to long term placement.

Job Summary

Staff support clients to develop and build on their existing living skills, in order to become more independent and move on to less supported accommodation at the end of their placement. Staff work in conjunction with other professionals to equip clients with the skills and motivation to become more independent and better able to manage their mental health.

Salary

The salary is paid monthly in arrears and will be £18,278 per annum (Additional Sleep-In payments are paid at £50.25). An employer's pension contribution of between 3% is also paid. The level of this contribution is reviewed annually.

Hours of Work

The hours of work will be 37 hours per week, shift working with some evening, weekends and bank holidays. You are also required to do sleep in shifts.

Annual Holidays

The annual leave entitlement will be 200 hours (27 working days) pro rata, rising 1 day for each year of service to a maximum of 237 hours (32 days) pro rata. All public bank holidays are granted with two extra statutory days, to be taken over the Christmas period.
