Project Summary

Oak House is a 14-bed registered residential recovery service for clients with mental health issues. Clients reside at Oak House for a period of between 2-5 years.

Job Summary

Staff support clients to develop and build on their existing living skills, in order to become more independent and move on to less supported accommodation at the end of their placement. Staff work in conjunction with other professionals to equip clients with the skills and motivation to become more independent and better able to manage their mental health.

Salary

The salary is paid monthly in arrears and will be £19,048 per annum. An employer's pension contribution of 3% is also paid. The level of this contribution is reviewed annually.

Hours of Work

The hours of work will be 22 hours per week, to cover Fridays, Saturdays & Sundays. Shift working with some evening, weekends and bank holidays. You are also required to carry out sleep in shifts.

Annual Holidays

The annual leave entitlement will be 200 hours (27 working days) pro rata, rising 1 day for each year of service to a maximum of 236 hours (32 days) pro rata. All public bank holidays are granted with two extra statutory days, to be taken over the Christmas period.
